NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Eligibility: Classes A and B

Format: 36-hole stroke play; 18-holes each day with a two tee system (Championship Flight and Tournament Flight). Ties for Low Gross after 36 holes necessitate a sudden death play-off starting on the first hole. First day pairings will be assigned according to handicap. Tuesday, June 15th, Championship Flight starting at 8AM, first tee (tenth tee unavailable in the morning). Tournament Flight (1st and 10th tees) starting time at 12:30 PM. Wednesday, June 16th, tee times starting at 8AM for the Tournament Flight followed by the Championship Flight.

Tees and Awards: A two tee system will be used: Championship Tees (5,922 yards **white** tees). Players must play from this tee to be eligible to win the Baker Trophy and receive Player of the Year points. Tournament Tees (5,375 yards **teal** tees) Gross and Net prize certificates will be awarded to those playing from this tee.

Weather Warning: No automatic system. Pro shop personnel will inform the WGAM Committee via radio and will blast out one long prolonged air horn note for a dangerous situation. Other types of suspension will be signaled by three consecutive air horn notes. Resumption of play by two short air horn notes.

Shelters: Restrooms at 7th tee, 10th tee, 14th tee and at the club house.

Yardage Markers: Sprinkler heads are marked on every hole to center of the green. At 150 yards, there is a barber pole in the center of fairway. In addition, there are plates in the fairway at 100, 150, and 200 yards.

Distance Measuring Devices: A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance **ONLY**. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

Flags: All flags are the same and not color coded for positions on the greens.

Hole location sheets: Will be provided.

Scorecards: To be exchanged and upon completion of the round, **IMMEDIATELY go to the Scorer's Table in the Linx Pavilion** where scorecards will be verified, signed and attested. **Please do not leave the scoring area until an official checks your scorecard.**

USGA Rules govern all play except as modified by the attached local rules. Players should refer to the WGAM Rules of Play and Conditions of Competition "hard card" for additional definitions, local rules and conditions. Read the WGAM pace of play policy. The Committee will monitor your times on the 4th, 9th, 13th and 18th holes for pace of play.

Rulings are to be made by the WGAM officials only. If a rules official cannot readily be summoned, play a second ball in accordance with Rule 3-3 (Doubt as to procedure). Remember that the competitor must report the facts of the situation to the committee **BEFORE SIGNING AND RETURNING HER SCORECARD.**
