



**GRACE KEYES CUP  
PLYMOUTH COUNTRY CLUB  
JULY 26 & 27, 2010**

**TOURNAMENT HISTORY:** *The tournament was established in 1950 when Grace Keyes presented the Keyes Cup to the WGAM for an annual stroke play competition. In 1900, Ms. Keyes, a member of the Concord Country Club, was one of the six founding members of the Women's Golf Association of Boston (later the Women's Golf Association of Massachusetts). She served as President of the organization from 1902 through 1907.*

**NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

**FORMAT:** 36-hole Stroke play (18 holes each day). In case of a tie for Low Gross after 36 holes, there will be a playoff starting on hole #1, then going on to 2, 3, and 4, continuing play of these four holes as necessary. If, for any reason, the second round is cancelled, the player with the lowest gross score after the first round will be declared the Champion. If, in this case, there is a tie for Low Gross after the first round, co-champions will be declared.

**AWARDS:** Champion's name will be engraved on the Keyes Cup. Prize certificates (gross only).

**PLAYER OF THE YEAR POINTS:** Awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 16<sup>th</sup> place.

**MID-AMATEUR AWARD:** The 36-hole score will be used.

**ONE-BALL CONDITION IN EFFECT:** You must use the same brand and specific type of ball for your entire round each day or be subject to penalty (2 strokes/hole; maximum 4 strokes/round).

**TEES:** Play from the blue WGAM tee markers (5,981 yards).

**YARDAGE MARKERS:** Sprinkler heads are marked to the center of the green.

**FLAG LOCATION:** Flags are color-coded. Red denotes front half of the green hole location; white is back half of the green hole location. Hole location sheets will be given to competitors each day.

**WATER HAZARDS:** Identified by yellow stakes and defined by yellow lines.

**LATERAL WATER HAZARDS:** Identified by red stakes and defined by red lines.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** White stakes

**WEATHER WARNING:** One long horn blast signals DANGEROUS SITUATION. Discontinue play and return to clubhouse immediately. No shelters on the course.

**ELECTRONIC DEVICES:** No cell phones on the course! Cannot use one with an "app" for distance measuring! Distance measuring devices ONLY (no wind or slope) are allowed.

**SECOND DAY PAIRINGS & TEE TIMES:** Posted on the WGAM web site ([www.wgam.org](http://www.wgam.org)) as soon as possible after the conclusion of the first day of play. You may also call the Pro Shop until 6pm (508-746-0476) or call Cindy Zattich (978-844-2893).

***RULINGS TO BE MADE BY WGAM OFFICIALS ONLY***

***USGA RULES GOVERN PLAY (except as modified by Local Rules). See separate Rules sheet.***

**SCORE CARDS:** To be exchanged. On completion of round, verify, sign, and attest. WRITE LEGIBLY. Turn in card immediately to official at scorer's table. DO NOT go to your car first.

***The WGAM will automatically post all competitors' scores from this tournament. They will be posted with a "T". PLEASE DO NOT POST YOUR OWN SCORES FROM THIS EVENT!***

**GROUP PACE OF PLAY:** In effect today. Read your Pace of Play paperwork to avoid any slow play penalties. Ask Registration or Starter if you have any questions.

**PLAYER INFORMATION SHEET**

**Golf carts:** Walking/carrying permitted (no push/pull carts), but, entry fee includes cart for Day 1 with no rebate. The cart fee for Day 2 is \$21, payable in the Pro Shop (credit card only).

**Caddies:** May bring own caddie, but must walk and carry the bag.

**Range Balls:** Included both days (130 yds maximum and driving net).

**Restrooms:** Clubhouse and near 10<sup>th</sup> tee.

**Drinking water:** On course every three holes; also, iced towels at hole #10. (Please do not use to clean your clubs.)

**Food Service:** Coffee and pastry are included in your entry fee and will be available upstairs in the dining room. Lunch is not included in your entry fee, but is available to order upstairs from 10:30 AM (please allow plenty of time). They can box it for you to take on the course. Also, there is a Snack Bar open on the 10<sup>th</sup> hole. Food is CREDIT CARD or CHARGE BACK to your home course tab (certain clubs only). NO CASH
