**THE ANNE MARIE TOBIN  
PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD**

The Anne Marie Tobin Player of the Year Award was first presented in 1994 and is named in honor of Anne Marie Tobin, President of the WGAM in 1994-1995 and seven-time winner of the Association Championship (1988, 1991-1995 and 2000). It is given to the WGAM member who earns the most Player of the Year points each year. The Player of the Year will be determined by a system which awards points on the basis of performance in WGAM events, USGA events and other regional and national competitions. In the event of a tie in the final standings of the Player of the Year, co-winners will be named. The recipient of this award will be appropriately honored at the Annual Meeting. Her name will be added to a plaque that is displayed in the WGAM office.

## PURPOSE

The WGAM is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization, designed for charitable and educational purposes related to golf. We seek to nurture, foster, and promote the development of women and junior girl amateur golfers; and to create for golfers opportunities for instruction, participation, and friendly competition in amateur golf.

## MEMBERSHIPS

### Clubs

Member clubs pay annual dues of \$125.00. Acceptance of membership in the WGAM binds each club to make its course available for a WGAM tournament (not including Spring Team and Fall Cup Matches) at least once every five years at mutually agreeable dates, with no charge for green fees to either the WGAM or tournament participants.

### Individuals

- Players must be current paid members of the WGAM to participate in any WGAM tournament.
- *Regular Member:* Any female amateur golfer who is a member of, or associated with, a WGAM member club, has an active up-to-date USGA 18-hole handicap index of 36.0 or less, and pays annual dues of \$65.00. Please note: If the club to which you belong fails to pay its dues or honor its responsibilities to the WGAM, it may be necessary to rescind your WGAM membership.
- *Young Adult Member:* A female who is aged 19 to 22 who meets all other membership requirements and pays annual dues of \$35.00.
- *Associate Member:* A female who is a member of, or associated with, a WGAM member club and pays annual dues \$25.00. **She is not eligible for tournament play;** however, she is entitled to other privileges of membership. If during the year an associate's up-to-date USGA handicap falls within the eligible range to compete in WGAM tournaments, she may notify the office, pay the pro rata difference between the Associate and Regular member dues, and enter those events for which she is eligible.
- *Junior member:* A Junior may also play in our women's tournaments by joining the association and paying annual dues of \$25.00.
- Juniors who wish to receive WGAM mailings and Junior Tournament information should call the WGAM office for placement on the mailing list. It is not necessary for juniors to join the WGAM if they are playing **ONLY** in Junior events.

## **POLICY ON DISCRIMINATION**

The WGAM deplors discrimination against anyone, in any situation. As a women's association, we are particularly sensitive to those instances where individuals are denied fair and equal access to golf facilities. We are grateful that those who feel they have been treated in a discriminatory manner have legal recourse to address their complaints and to remedy any wrong treatment. The WGAM is comprised of member clubs and of individual members. We are not a judicial entity and are not in the position to judge an issue if one of our members comes into conflict with one of our member clubs. The WGAM will take no position in such a dispute.

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

A person whose conduct or behavior for which a specific penalty is assigned under the Rules of Golf will be subject to that penalty. Certain behaviors and breaches of conduct for which no penalty is assigned under the USGA Rules of Golf will be subject to censure, suspension, or revocation of the privilege of playing in WGAM events. Examples of such behaviors and conduct appear below.

## **USE OF CELL PHONES**

Use of all cellular phones to make or receive calls and/or texting is prohibited at host course sites (EXCEPT to report a medical emergency). Players who use such devices in the prohibited manner while on host club or course property, in breach of WGAM and the club's policy, are subject to sanction by the WGAM, e.g., revocation of playing privileges in WGAM events. Use of a multi-functional device such as a smart phone or PDA to access the Rules of Golf and/or as an approved Distance Measuring Device (DMD) is permissible, provided such use is allowed by the Host Club and the device meets all the required limitations (i.e., it must measure distance only). If such a device is used during a stipulated round to ask for or give advice in breach of Rule 8-1, the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, the penalty for which is disqualification (Decision 14-3/16).

## **DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE POLICY**

In all WGAM tournaments (including Spring Teams and Fall Cup), unless otherwise stated in the "Conditions of the Competition" or announced at the event, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance ONLY.

However, if during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc...), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is two strokes in Stroke Play or Loss of Hole in Match Play. A subsequent offense is disqualification.

Distance, topography, or geographical information is not considered advice and as such may be shared. Sharing of such information is not required but is encouraged.

### **MINIMUM ROUNDS POSTED TO GHIN**

To be eligible to participate in WGAM events, a player must have posted a minimum of eight 18-hole scores in the 12 months prior to the Handicap Revision date of the event being entered.

### **PERSONAL CONDUCT**

Competitors are expected to display good sportsmanship, to respect the golf course and club property, to behave courteously in dealing with other competitors, club members, and employees, to dress appropriately, and to play with proper course etiquette. Section 1 of the *Rules of Golf* (“Etiquette; Behavior on the Course”) provides some guidelines. Members whose personal conduct is deemed unbecoming to the WGAM may be subject to censure or denied entry to future events.

### **DRESS CODE**

The WGAM depends on its members to dress in good taste. Gym shorts, short shorts, blue jeans, tank tops, and bare feet are considered inappropriate. Shorts and skirts should be appropriate golf length. Shirts and tops must be long enough to tuck in. Be advised that some clubs have dress codes which are more strict, and as their guests we will adhere to all of their rules. The WGAM office will provide dress code information from hosting clubs to players prior to each tournament. Members whose dress is deemed inappropriate by the WGAM may be denied participation in the tournament. In the case of a mixed competition, it is the responsibility of the WGAM member to inform her partner of the WGAM dress code.

### **HANDICAP INFORMATION**

The USGA Handicap Index revision date that will be used to determine eligibility of entry for each tournament will be listed with the tournament entry information (found in the Tournament Details section).

The maximum handicap index limit for membership is 36.0. The maximum number of strokes allotted when an index is converted to a home handicap will be 36. In the case of a tournament that uses a percentage of handicap, the percentage will be of a number no higher than 36.

**Other Handicap Information:**

- A player is required to record a score for a hole not finished, not played, or not played under the *Rules of Golf* and to adjust (for posting) any hole score when it is higher than the maximum number allowed under ESC.
- If a player starts but does not complete a hole or is conceded a stroke, that player shall record for handicap purposes the score most likely to be made. When recorded, the score is to be preceded by an “X.”
- There is no limit to the number of unfinished holes a player may have in a round, provided that failure to finish is not for the purpose of handicap manipulation.
- If a player does not play a hole or plays it other than under the *Rules of Golf* (except for preferred lies), the score for that hole for handicap purposes shall be par plus any handicap strokes received on the hole. When recorded, the score is to be preceded by an “X.”
- If 13 or more holes are played, the player shall post an 18-hole score. If 7 to 12 holes are played, the player shall post a 9-hole score.
- Post all 9-hole scores. Two 9-hole scores will be combined to create an 18-hole score.
- Scores from WGAM tournaments must be posted as “T” scores. Where expressly specified in the Notice to Competitors, the WGAM Committee will post the scores returned by the player.
- Scores while playing alone are not acceptable scores to be entered for handicap purposes.

## APPLYING TO PLAY IN A TOURNAMENT

*Tournament participants agree to hold the WGAM, its agents and employees, harmless and free from all claims, demands and liabilities arising out of any loss or damage suffered by said member in connection with any tournament entered. The WGAM reserves the right to photograph participants in and at WGAM events. These photos may be used in conjunction with WGAM promotions including publications and/or the WGAM website.*

- All tournaments are open to WGAM individual members who conform to USGA Rules of Amateur Status per the Rules of Golf. Eligibility for a given tournament is determined by the player's active up-to-date USGA 18-hole handicap index as of the designated Revision Date, and that she has posted a minimum of eight 18-hole scores in the prior 12 months. GHIN handicap must be from a club that is a paid member of WGAM.
- Player eligibility (GHIN, number of rounds posted) is verified after the Revision Date. Players who are found not eligible will be notified immediately.
- Entries can be made by either: online registration (preferred), or print an entry form from the WGAM website and mail it in with a check for the appropriate fee. USGA Revision Dates are adhered to for eligibility purposes. Entries to an event will be accepted not earlier than April 3, 2017 and not later than the Closing Date specified for a particular tournament (before 11:59 pm EST).
- The first time you register for a tournament online please verify that your personal information is correct. Please update and also notify the office with any changes so that all databases used for different aspects of tournaments can be updated (phone: 774-430-9010).
- Once an online entry has been completed, the member will immediately receive an email indicating either they are registered for the tournament (assuming eligibility requirements are met); **or** they are on a wait list because the tournament is currently filled. If you do not get an email pre-registration acknowledgement from the WGAM office within a few hours of entering, the entry was not received and you should call the WGAM office at (774) 430-9010.
- Credit cards are not charged until after a tournament's Close Date.
- Entering most tournaments is now on a first come, first served basis (began 2015). Members will get a spot to play in these tournaments based on when they sign up (chronologically), assuming they meet all eligibility requirements and regardless of whether or not they won one of these tournaments last year.
- **The following tournaments will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis:** Allen Bowl, B/C/D/E Class Championships, Cris Eaton, Curtis Bowl, LaBonte, Mother & Daughter, Member/Junior, Mother & Son, Prunaret,

Senior Championship, Townshend, Stone Cup, and Sheeran.

- For partner tournaments, if a member enters with a partner, then chooses to change to a different partner for any reason, she must withdraw her entire entry and complete a new online entry with the replacement partner (effectively going to the back of the registration line with her new partner).
- Mailed-in entries will be accepted for these tournaments. They will be date stamped upon receipt (*not earlier than 7:00 AM EST on April 3, 2017 and not later than 11:59 PM EST on the Closing Date*). Incomplete entries will not be accepted. Data from mailed-in applications will be entered into the online registration system. As with online entries, the registrant will receive an email indicating that she is either registered for the tournament, or she is on a wait-list.

**Three tournaments are not filled on a first come, first served basis.**

**Participants in the following tournaments will be determined after the Closing Dates, (as they have been in the past):**

Amateur Championship, Baker, Keyes

- Members can enter these tournaments either online or by sending in a form (with fee) anytime after 7:00 AM EST on April 3, 2017 but before the Closing Date.
- Oversubscription for Amateur, Keyes, Baker: participation in these tournaments will be by index: low to high.
- Defending Champions will be guaranteed a spot in these competitions if they have registered within the Opening and Closing dates of the event.

**Multi-State Tournaments (Griscom, NEWGA, Endicott and USGA State Championships)**

- The Griscom Cup and USGA Women's State Championship teams are chosen by the State Team Captain and her committee using criteria approved by the Board of Directors.
- The NEWGA Championship and the Endicott Cup will be filled according to guidelines agreed upon by the tournaments' committees, generally low to high indices.

**Other Tournament Registration Information:**

- Requests to play on specific days may not be honored and are within the sole discretion of the Tournament Committee. Exception: reasonable attempts are made to honor pairing requests for the Sheeran Trophy, Mother/Daughter, Member/Junior, and Mother/Son tournaments.
- The Committee and WGAM reserve the right to determine pairings and change course yardages any time before the start of the tournament. Yardages for a tournament may be different than those posted on the Host course's website or on associated Internet sites (e.g. Blue Golf).

## TOURNAMENT PLAY

- The Rules of the USGA and its Decisions govern play. *Rules of Golf* claims, penalties, disputes, and doubtful points will be settled by the Rules Officials/ Committees of the Competition and/or the Board of the WGAM.
- All rules decisions will be made by WGAM Rules Officials ONLY.
- Tournaments will be run in accordance with Host Club requirements, and will be stated in the Conditions of the Competition for each event.
- Outside caddies, if allowed, must be cleared with the Host Club Pro Shop.
- Practice rounds will be at the discretion of the Host Club.
- If a Host Club mandates the use of motorized golf carts, the WGAM is not liable for accidents. Players using (or sharing) carts should have accident coverage under their personal policies.
- No player who is under the age of 18 may operate a motorized golf cart unless he or she has a valid motor vehicle license.
- Players are urged to support the Host Club's dining facilities and Pro Shop.
- Metal WGAM markers (lollipops) will indicate each hole's tee location.
- ***Pace of play*** is a major concern to the WGAM. Rules Officials will enforce Rule 6-7 on undue delay in both match and stroke play and, if necessary, issue penalties. Each player should be aware of the group in front of her and make every attempt to keep her place on the course.
- Overall Local Rules and Condition of the Competition, (including equipment and shoes) are on the WGAM website under "hard card."

## WITHDRAWAL/NO SHOW/NO CARD/DEFAULT

- A minimum of \$20.00 will be charged when a player withdraws after the close date but before the pairings are made. **If a withdrawal is less than five days before an event, the refund is 50% of the entry fee.**
- If a withdrawal is necessary after the registration close date, the WGAM must be notified. No substitution or changes of entries can be made by the player(s) without prior clearance by the WGAM.
- Outside of office hours, please email: [info@wgam.org](mailto:info@wgam.org) to notify the WGAM of all withdrawals. A "no show" for an assigned tee time should be explained in an email as soon as possible.
- Competitors must play to the conclusion of an event; a subsequent day "no show" or default in match play will result in review. In stroke play, failure to turn in the scorecard or withdrawal during play without notifying an official and surrendering the scorecard will also be reviewed by the Committee. In match play, the winner should report the match results to the scoring area immediately upon conclusion of the match. All defaults will be subject to review by the Board of Directors.

### **AWARDS/PRIZES**

- Permanent trophies established for championships and major tournaments will be engraved with the winners' names.
- Other awards may be given in the form of prizes or prize certificates.
- The size of the field in a tournament will determine the number of awards.
- A player may win only one award in a stroke play tournament.  
*Exceptions: Amateur Championship, Senior Championship, Mother & Son, Mother & Daughter, and Stone Cup.*

### **USGA MATCH OF CARDS PROCEDURE:**

An acceptable method of matching cards in the event of a tie is to determine the winner on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes played. If the tying players have the same score for the last nine, determine the winner on the basis of the last six holes, last three holes and finally the 18th hole. If this method is used in a competition with a multiple tee start (1 & 10 or a shotgun), it is recommended that the "last nine holes, last six holes, etc..." is considered to be holes 10-18, 13-18, etc... and that this be announced in advance.

### **TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICIES**

- Pairings are made after the event's closing date. The WGAM Tournament Committee is solely responsible for cancellation of tournament days. The WGAM reserves the right to cancel an event due to lack of participation. There will be no guarantee of a refund of tournament entry fees after the closing date unless the WGAM cancels a tournament. A partial refund may be approved by the Board of Directors under extraordinary circumstances. Requests for refunds will only be accepted in writing. The amount of the refund, if any, may be reduced by tournament costs.

**JUNIOR TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY:**

In order to play in WGAM junior tournaments, a girl cannot have reached her 19th birthday nor begun her first semester of college. She must be a Massachusetts resident or have a parent or guardian who is a member of, or associated with, a Massachusetts club.

**It is ONLY necessary for juniors to join the WGAM if they are playing in WGAM Women's events.**

Juniors who wish to receive information about tournaments and/or be added to the WGAM mailing list should call the WGAM office or visit [www.wgam.org](http://www.wgam.org).

**PARTICIPATION IN JUNIOR TOURNAMENTS IS BY AGE:**

**JUNIOR CLASS:** *Ages 14-18 years of age.* Any girl who has not reached her 19th birthday by the first day of the tournament. A competitor of 18 years of age is eligible only if she has not yet begun her first semester of college.

**JUNIOR-JUNIOR CLASS:** *Ages 11-13.* Any girl who has not reached her 14th birthday by the first day of the tournament.

**MITE CLASS:** *Age 10 or younger.* Any girl who has not reached her 11th birthday by the first day of the tournament.

**WGAM JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP:** A junior is eligible to become a WGAM Junior Member and participate in WGAM women's tournaments. The junior must have an active handicap from a WGAM member club and that handicap index must be 36.0 or below. Payment of \$25.00 annual dues is necessary to participate in the women's tournaments.

**YOUNG ADULT MEMBER:** A female who is aged 19 to 22 who meets all other membership requirements and pays a dues of \$35.00

### **DRESS CODE:**

The Association requires its juniors to dress in good taste. Gym shorts, short shorts, blue jeans, sweat pants, tank tops, cropped tops and bare feet are considered inappropriate. The dress code at Junior Tournaments will be determined by the dress code of the course where the event is played. The dress code will be sent out with the tee times, local rules and player information by email. We will adhere to all of the host club's rules. Girls whose dress is deemed inappropriate by the WGAM may be denied participation in the tournament.

### **PERSONAL CONDUCT : SEE PAGE 31**

### **PACE OF PLAY:**

Is a major concern to the WGAM. WGAM Rules Officials will enforce USGA Rule 6-7 on undue delay and, if necessary, issue penalties. Each player should be constantly aware of the group in front of her and should make every attempt to keep her place on the course.

### **OPERATION OF GOLF CART BY MINOR:**

No player who is under 18 may operate a motorized golf cart unless she has a valid motor vehicle license.

Juniors may use push or pull carts in WGAM events if allowed by the host club.

**TEAM MATCHES:** The Inner-City and Tri State Team matches are selected by the WGAM Junior Committee. Selected players will be notified by invitation.

All Juniors are expected to comply with all USGA Rules of Golf and should pay close attention to the WGAM codes for Dress, Conduct and Pace of Play criteria.

## **APPLYING TO PLAY IN A TOURNAMENT:**

*Tournament participants agree to hold the WGAM, its agents, servants, and employees, harmless and free from all claims, demands, and liabilities arising out of any loss or damage suffered by said member in connection with any tournament entered. The WGAM reserves the right to photograph participants in and at WGAM events. These photos may be used in conjunction with WGAM promotions including publications and/or the WGAM website.*

- Entries can be made by either: online registration (preferred), or print an entry form from the WGAM website and mail it in with a check for the appropriate fee. USGA Revision Dates are adhered to for eligibility purposes. Entries to an event will be accepted not earlier than April 3, 2017 and not later than the Closing Date specified for a particular tournament (before 11:59 pm EST).
- The first time you register for a tournament online please verify that your personal information is correct. Please update and also notify the office with any changes so that all databases used for different aspects of tournaments can be updated (phone: 774-430-9010).

## **WITHDRAWALS:**

*If a withdrawal is necessary, the WGAM must be notified. No substitutions or changes of entries can be made by the players in any tournament without prior clearance by the WGAM Junior Committee. Withdrawals should be made IN WRITING by email sent to [info@wgam.org](mailto:info@wgam.org). The day before or the day of the tournament, the WGAM Office must be notified. Failure to comply with these rulings may result in a denial of entry from said event the following year.*

Competitors must play to the conclusion of a tournament.

The WGAM wants juniors to compete in as many tournaments as possible. We realize there may be two tournaments with the same date and propose the juniors enter both tournaments. When you are certain that you have qualified for a higher-level tournament, you should withdraw from the WGAM Junior event. Please call WGAM at (774) 430-9010 as soon as possible. Follow up in writing with a letter or email ([info@wgam.org](mailto:info@wgam.org)) identifying the higher-level event for which you have qualified. The WGAM will refund a portion of your entry fee to our event IF your reason for the withdrawal is qualification into a higher-level tournament.

### **WGAM SPECTATOR POLICY:**

We welcome and encourage parents and spectators to attend all WGAM Junior events. To maximize the enjoyment for all our Junior golfers, and abide by the Rules of Golf, we ask that parents and spectators adhere to the following Code of Conduct:

Note: If any of the following guideline are perceived as a violation by a WGAM official, the player may be subject to penalty.

1. Keep your conversation with the player to words of encouragement, not advice. (Advice is any counsel or suggestions that could influence a player in determining her play, the choice of a club or the method of making a stroke.) Any conversation between player and spectator may be construed as advice, including words or conversation in any language. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators. Penalty for each breach of this rule is two strokes.
2. A WGAM Rules official may assess a penalty to the player based on the severity of the spectator violation. If a serious breach has occurred, the spectator may be asked to leave the facility or may not be permitted to attend another WGAM junior event.
3. Spectators **MUST NOT** give rulings. Please seek a WGAM official if needed.
4. Golf carts are not allowed for spectators at any Junior event under any circumstance.
5. Spectators should stay on cart paths. If there are no cart paths, spectators should stay in the rough. Please stay off fairways, tees and greens unless otherwise noted.
6. Spectators should stay **ONE SHOT** ahead of the group they are following. This allows spectators to follow errant shots and help identify the area where balls have landed. Spectators are allowed to aid in the search for lost golf balls.
7. Spectators are requested to be fair and equal to all competitors when cheering and clapping. Let's all show good sportsmanship by example.
8. Spectators must adhere to the rules of the host club and not use the facilities (course, practice range, etc.), unless he/she is a current member of the host club.
9. Spectators will be allowed to carry medicine, water, umbrellas, jackets, towels and food for players. Interaction allowed with the players will be limited to **ONLY** the exchange of such items.
10. The WGAM will make every effort to have a volunteer with the Mite (10 and under) groups. If, however, we do not have enough volunteers for every Mite group, we may ask the parents who are following the groups to help the other girls other than their own child.

## **THE FRANCIS OUIMET SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

Francis Ouimet Scholarships are available to students who have given at least two years of service to the game of golf as caddies, or as assistants to golf professionals or course superintendents, at Massachusetts golf courses. Candidates must have established financial need and applied to an accredited college or university. The deadline for completed online applications is December 1, 2017 for the 2018-2019 academic year.

The Ouimet Fund strongly encourages women to apply for a scholarship. In the 2016-2017 academic year, the Ouimet Fund awarded 317 financial Scholarships, totaling \$1.85 Million. In addition to the WGAM/Dolly Sullivan Scholarship, the Ouimet Fund has over 130 endowed awards open to Ouimet Scholars, several of which are for females only. Applicants need only apply for the Ouimet Scholarship and the Ouimet Committees match Scholars with specific endowed awards.

- One of these endowed scholarships was created in honor of former WGAM President, the late Mildred Gardinor Prunaret. The 2016-2017 Prunaret Scholarship has been awarded to Danielle K. Cassista and Carli N. Citrano.
- The Margaret Lowery Award was established in 2000 in memory of Margaret Lowery, widow of Eddie Lowery. Mrs. Lowery died in June of 2000 and was a great friend and supporter of the Ouimet Fund. The 2016-2017 Margaret Lowery recipient is Kelsey J. Frahlich.
- The Adele Foley Scholarship was established in 1998 and was the first Ouimet endowed award specifically designated for female Scholars. Adele Foley was the wife of Bill Foley, Ouimet Alumnus and former President of both the Ouimet Fund and the Massachusetts Golf Association. The 2016-2017 award was presented to Samantha R. Cuomo.
- The Priscilla D. Ramsey Scholarship was established in 2005 through gifts of the Marie G. Dennett Foundation, with which Mrs. Ramsey was involved for many years. The Priscilla D. Ramsey Scholarship was established in honor of the late Mrs. Ramsey to help needy Ouimet Scholars. The 2016-2017 award was presented to Carli N. Citrano.
- The Scannell Family Scholarship was established in 2014 by Ouimet Alumnus Patrick Scannell and his family. The award is for inner-city female Scholars and the 2016-2017 award was presented to Julianne Coleman.

- The Carolyn S. Savage Scholarship was established in 2015 by long-time Ouimet Society Lifetime Member and applicant interviewer, Mrs. Savage. The award is for female Scholars from the Greater Boston or Cape Cod areas, and the 2016-2017 award was presented to Shaye T. Macurdy.

### **THE WGAM/DOLLY SULLIVAN SCHOLARSHIP**
